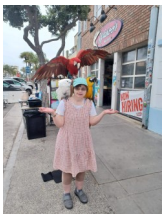


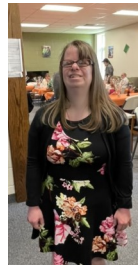
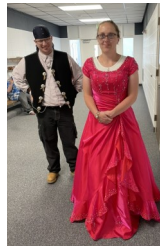
Lincoln Self Reliance Review July 2022

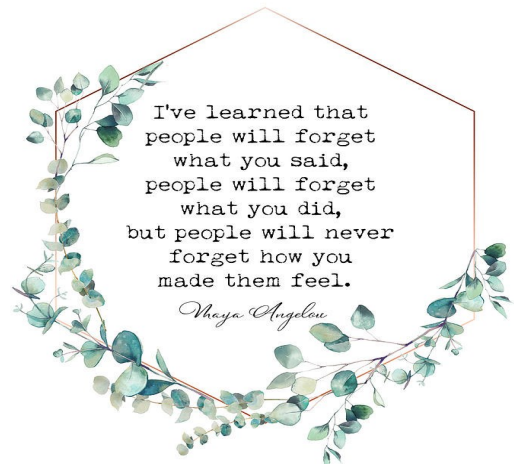

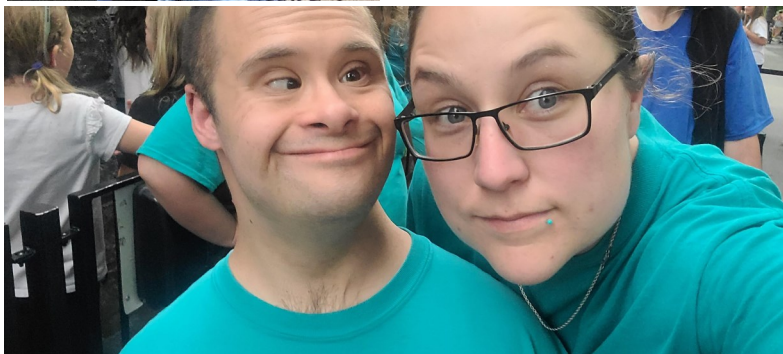
Amanda Bagley
